



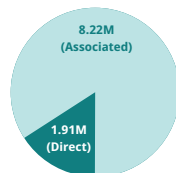

Why it Matters:

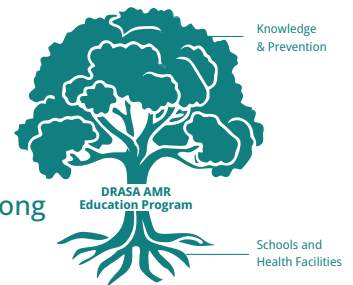
Facts:

Globally, AMR is projected to cause **1.91** million deaths annually directly and be associated with another **8.22** million deaths by 2050.*



Our Solution:

DRASA mainstreams AMR education in schools and health facilities to build lifelong prevention habits



Developing Youth Health Champions for AMR



Established Health & Hygiene Clubs in **30** schools in **2** states



Trained **2,000** students who went on to train **8,332** others (multiplier effect)

Taking AMR to the Streets

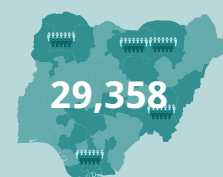

29,358 people directly reached in **10** states across all **6** geopolitical zones

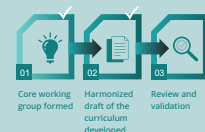
Embedding AMR in Secondary School Curricula



Collaboration with the government, civil society, and the private sector




Goal: embed an AMR module in Nigeria's secondary school curriculum




Progress: Core working group formed; harmonized draft of the curriculum developed for review and validation

Innovating with the SayAMR Language Hackathon




Competition to translate “antimicrobial resistance” into Hausa, Igbo, Pidgin & Yoruba led by linguistics & science students in universities



Goal: Break language barriers, simplify AMR terms, gain national consensus on the language of AMR

Progress: Hackathon launched; applications being received; national unveiling March 2026
