- High disease burden & travel and mobility = increased risk of outbreaks


Our Solution:

13 emergency management teams established at Points of Entry in **9** states



6,162 border community residents equipped: market women, transport workers



61% Knowledge increase, from 42.6% at baseline to 68% at endline

Focus: Embedding youth & civil society in health governance to make health security inclusive & data-driven



Cohort 1: **34** youth and civil society onboarded from **14** states
